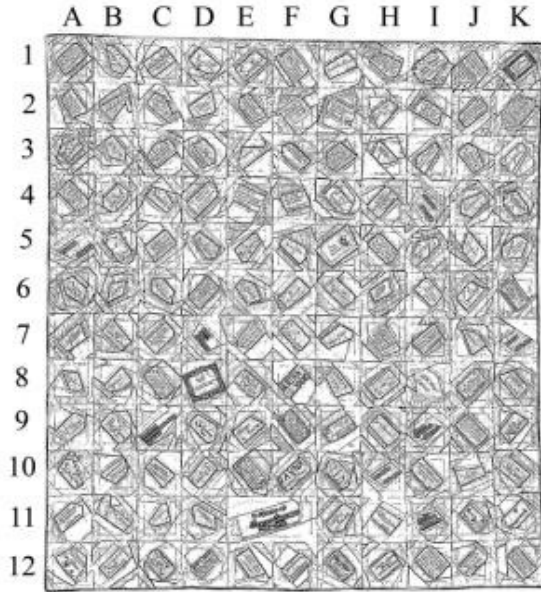


Women's Section Quilt Documentation
